Dear Year 1 Families

Our Learning Journey for the first half of the Summer Term is '**LARGER than Life!**' The children will be exploring all things giant in both the imaginary and real world. Please see the attached overview for details of how this Learning Journey will be explored through the curriculum and 'leaves' for you to share and complete in big writing with your child so that we can discuss as classes what the children already know and would like to find out about during the Learning Journey.

As a 'Super Start', we are inviting the children to bring in a copy of their favourite fairy tale and a prop (clue), for others to guess which story they have chosen. These will form a 'guessing table' in each class, and will begin our English curriculum exploration of stories containing giant things. Please encourage your child to bring these into school during the first full week back.

As usual, there will be much to look forward to in the new term. We are planning a 'Marvellous Middle' whereby the children will get to make a giant collaborative sculpture around our class text and we will round up our learning with a 'Fabulous Finish' trip to the Seven Sisters Country Park and an Open Afternoon. As always, we would love the children to continue to bring in any books, pictures or items of interest to support our Learning Journey.
