Dear Stanford Infant Family

Thank you for completing the form on SchoolPing. I am writing to update you with the arrangements we have in place to provide provision for your children from tomorrow.

As we had always been working in class bubbles, we have decided to continue in this way, so that the children receive the same quality provision they would normally receive from their class teacher and teaching assistant. We felt this was safest option, given that we had worked so hard not to mix bubbles before now! It will also ease the transition when we open fully again.

Therefore, your child should come to school at their normal time on each day via the back entrance, to ensure we still have a staggered start/collection in operation. The one-way system will still be in operation. As before, we would kindly request that all parents/carers wear a face covering whilst on School Grounds. All our rigorous control measures will remain in place and we will continuously review our Risk Assessment.

Children are to wear our relaxed School Uniform to school. They just need to bring their own water bottle and a healthy snack to school. Please do not send them in with bags, toys or books. If you need to return any school items, please place them in the box provided by the Main Office. The School Meals Team is able to provide the Hot Meal Option from the two-choice option. A copy of the menu is attached and we are on Week 2.

Breakfast Club will be in operation daily as usual and if you have said you require Breakfast Club provision, we already have you on the register. If you did not select this option but would like to take advantage of it, please email [breakfastclub@stanford-inf.brighton-hove.sch.uk](mailto:breakfastclub@stanford-inf.brighton-hove.sch.uk).

As before, if your child is unwell, please do not send them to school. We understand that some of our community tested positive for Covid over Christmas; however, they did not have the three main symptoms. It is therefore of vital importance that everyone is vigilant and does not attend the school if they or their family members are unwell.

The staff team are working incredibly hard, and like many of you have sacrificed so much, in order to ensure they can safely be at work. We would kindly ask that all families take responsibility for continuing to adhere to the Tier 4 restrictions, to keep our whole school community healthy, safe and well, including our staff and their families.
