Dear Year 1 and Year 2 Families,

Through our Personal, Social, Health and Emotional Development (PSHE) work within the school we try to develop awareness of diversity and ways to celebrate this within our school. Each child within the school has the opportunity to design and create their own personal display to share with their class and wider school. This is a very successful and enjoyable experience for the children.

For **Year 1** children, this will involve each child 'owning' a special space in their class for a week. This can be used to show anything that holds a particular interest for your child. Examples could include a club that they like attending, a set of favourite toys or collection of objects or special stories.

For **Year 2** children, this will also involve each child 'owning' a special space in their class for a week, but in order to build on the displays they did in Year 1, we would ask that they think carefully about what is special about them, and to them, and how they might reflect this in their displays. The children will be encouraged to write captions to explain their choices and help them present their displays to their class. As in Year 1, this could involve sharing their involvement in a club or group or something entirely different.

Each child will know when their special time will be, and so will have time to decide and plan their display. The reason behind this idea is to highlight and celebrate the range of interest, cultures and differences each child brings to Stanford Infant School.

Class Timetables will be displayed on the doors where you collect your child from; however, please feel free to ask your child's teacher or email the School Office if you would like the date emailed to you.

Class teachers will have spoken to the children about the displays, but please feel free to see your class teacher if you have any further questions.
