



## **Stanford Infants School Council**

Minutes of Meeting – Friday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2022 @ 2:30pm

### **Who was there?**

Miss Denyer and all the School Councillors in Rec, Yr 1 & Yr 2.

### **What happened?**

**Welcome:** we met in the Staffroom and Lola from Ocean Class went through the agenda for the meeting.

**Minutes of Last Meeting** – Miss Denyer went through the minutes of the last meeting and these were agreed as correct.

**Class Feedback:** Lana from Regent Class asked about the possibility of a children's shed for celebrating difference – where children could share things that are special to them. Miss Denyer said she would consider how this could be incorporated into our stage area. Ellie from Palace Class explained that Harrison from her class had requested a Learning Journey that included learning about cars. Miss Denyer explained that she is a Formula 1 fan and so is sure this can be incorporated somewhere! 😊 Hector from Palace Class said it would be great to have some new toys to play with in Reception.

**Whole School Events:** Miss Denyer explained that we are rebuilding our whole school community. Year 1 and 2 reps talked about the assembly where we had talked about rebuilding and hope. Miss Denyer said that whole school assemblies would now take place on Wednesday afternoons at 2:40pm and our Celebration of Learning assembly would be on a Friday morning. All Year Groups would attend the Wednesday assembly and Years 1 and 2 children would attend the Friday assembly, with Reception visiting after half term. Golden Choices would be in Year Groups for Summer 1 and Whole School from Summer 2.

Lunchtimes would be slightly different for Years 1 and 2 children - once they have finished their meal and cleared their tray away, they can ask to leave the Hall to join friends in the playground. They can only leave the Hall if a school grown-up has said they can. They must walk quietly out onto the playground. Year 1 children will stay out until their class signs are raised. Year 2 children will wait for Mr Atwood to hold up a Year 2 sign and they can then make their way quietly and sensibly to their classroom.

Miss Denyer explained that we would trial this new arrangement next week (week beginning 2<sup>nd</sup> May). All children must uphold our values at all times in the school and playground and it is the responsibility of everyone to make sure that everyone feels safe and happy at all times.

Lunch Club will be available in Dolphin/Lagoon Activity Area with Miss Brooks; again, children need to ask a school grown-up before attending the club.

Owais from Pavilion Class was very excited about the new arrangements! He also told the reps that his family were celebrating Eid on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May.

Miss Denyer also said we were beginning to think about a Whole School Learning Journey for Summer 2 – ideas welcome!

**Whole School Safe and Happy Survey:** Miss Denyer asked if classes had shared the outcomes of the whole school survey; some had. As we were short of time, this agenda item will be included in the next meeting.

**Project for 21/22:** Miss Denyer reminded the children about our Community of Grounds linked with the City of Meadows and Children's Parade.
