

# Year Group Open Afternoons

Dear Stanford Infant Families

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the Year Group Afternoons planned for after half term.

We would like to invite you to join us at **one of two Open Afternoons**, on the following dates:

**Reception** – Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June OR Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June

**Year 1** – Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> June OR Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June

**Year 2** – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June OR Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June

Each afternoon will be structured as follows:

## **2:00pm – 2:30pm**

The children will share their learning with you in their learning environment. We will have our classrooms, activity areas, outside areas open as usual, and you will be able to share in some of the activities that your child may enjoy in a normal day. Your child may also teach you something during the afternoon!

## **2:30pm – 3:00pm**

Classes will tidy up as usual; adults will have tea and coffee in the playground/hall and then join the children for play. At 2:50pm they will settle back in their classrooms for a story and the normal end-of-day routine. At this point, you will be asked to leave your child as they re-join their class.

## **3:00pm**

Tea and coffee will be cleared away ready for home time. Please wait in the normal place to collect your child.

Due to space restrictions and the fact that the children will be exploring their environment freely, we ask that **younger siblings do not accompany you**. We hope that, with two afternoons provided, you may be able to share childcare with another family, alternating the day that you visit.

You will be sent a SchoolPing after half term. **Please sign up for your preferred day** so that we can share out the number of parents/carers visiting at each time and make it an enjoyable experience for all!

We fully appreciate that not all parents/carers will be able to attend due to work commitments etc. If this is the case, please inform your child's class teacher and we will ensure that your child is able to share their learning with a familiar adult in school.
